Aone+ are the managing agents working on behalf of the Highways Agency and we maintain the trunk roads and motorways in the East Midlands.

Thank you for your enquiry regarding litter at the above location. As part of our contract we are only obliged to clear litter once a year or when possible within any maintenance works where traffic management is in place. I have passed this onto our teams to clear this whenever it is possible.

You make reference to VMS signs displaying 'Bag it Bin' and the fact that you think they are not hard hitting enough and perhaps a fine would remedy the problem. This is, in principal a good idea, but this is an enforcement issue which would need to be carried out by the Police.

Through all our continued efforts to promote the message to the motorists who randomly discard their litter onto the road and therefore, endangering our workforce who have to clear this up after them, we still cannot determine their behaviour.
