The third information request you referred to was, I think, the one made on 10<sup>th</sup> February not on the 16<sup>th</sup> February.

I was pleased to read that a great deal of the work which is currently underway mirrors the suggestions in my letter to Graham Dalton and includes taking the maintenance of at least one area in-house.

Thank you for your invitation to a meeting. Please suggest some times and venues. Central London would suit me best. Guildford is an option provided the meeting is in the middle of the day. Please note I am away for the week of 20<sup>th</sup> April.

We should of course discuss all possible the ways of bringing Highways England into compliance with EPA S89(1).

With regard to the two information requests which you have refused I would draw your attention to your letter to me of 24<sup>th</sup> May 2012 also citing Regulation 12(4) (b) - request(s) are manifestly unreasonable. You may recall that the refusal was over turned by the Information Tribunal. Judge Angus Hamilton stated that:
