Dear Mr O'Sullivan,

Please find attached a revised Environmental Protection Act S91 Warning Notice.

I have already passed on to you numerous complaints from Clean Highways supporters about the littered condition of the A13.

While I have focused in the notice on just this lay-by I can assure you that on Friday every single meter of A13 verge and central reservation from the Wennington junction to the junction with the A1089 was badly littered. [See link to Google maps.](#)

In the notice I have included links to videos showing the condition of the lay-by on [15<sup>th</sup> September](#) and [14<sup>th</sup> October](#). Clearly no cleaning had taken place in the interim period as the same items are visible in both. It looks as if the whole area has been abandoned by your contractors for several months.

I invite you and Peter Antolik of the Office of Rail and Road to join me this week to make a joint tour of the area and of the A1089 spur to Tilbury. Hopefully Rob Gledhill, the Leader of Thurrock Council will be able to join us. He has as you may know been at odds with HE about the condition of this latter road.

If you are agreeable please suggest a time.
