Dear Mr Silverman,

Thank you for your email of 27 April about HWRC charges. I have been asked to reply and I apologise for the delay in doing so.

As was set out in the Litter Strategy 2017, WRAP was asked to review its existing guidance on HWRCs, to ensure this reflects changes made in the law during 2015 through the Local Authorities (Prohibition of Charging Residents to Deposit Household Waste) Order 2015 and the Local Government (Prohibition of Charges at Household Waste Recycling Centres)(England) Order 2015) and to give further guidance on what can be charged for at HWRCs especially in respect of DIY waste arising from activities a householder might reasonably be expected to carry out themselves.

New guidance is expected later this year.
