Nick,

Please refer to [this link showing the division of responsibilities](#) between Connect Plus (red), UK Highways M40 (yellow) South Bucks (blue). I assume this map is still current.

Also, please look at the attached photograph I have been sent of fly-tipping on the **inside of the island in an area which is not colour coded on the map.**

I am trying to work out who is responsible for the this area and what obligations they have for removing it. To this end I have a number of questions:

1. Is it part of a relevant highway (EPA S89 (1) (ba)) for which HE is responsible?
2. Does HE own or control the area?
3. Is the maintenance and/or cleansing of it part of your contract with Connect Plus or any other contractor?
4. Has HE, or any of its contractors reported the fly-tipping to anyone and, if so, to whom?
5. What other action, if any, does HE intend to take to get the waste removed and prevent more fly-tipping on it?
